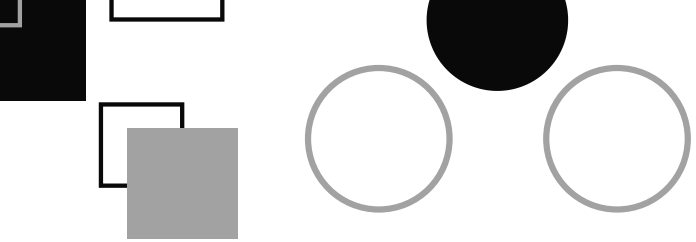


DEFINE GOALS AND SET A BUDGET

Determine a realistic budget range by considering factors like the scope of the remodel, desired materials, and professional assistance required.



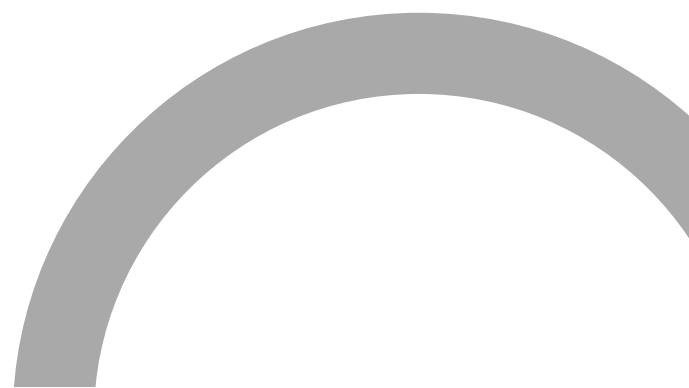
RESEARCH AND GATHER INSPIRATION

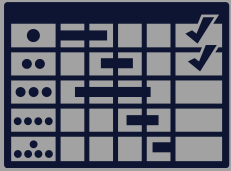
Explore various sources such as magazines, websites, and social media platforms to gather ideas and inspiration for the desired kitchen design.

CABINETS, COUNTERTOPS, AND FLOORING.



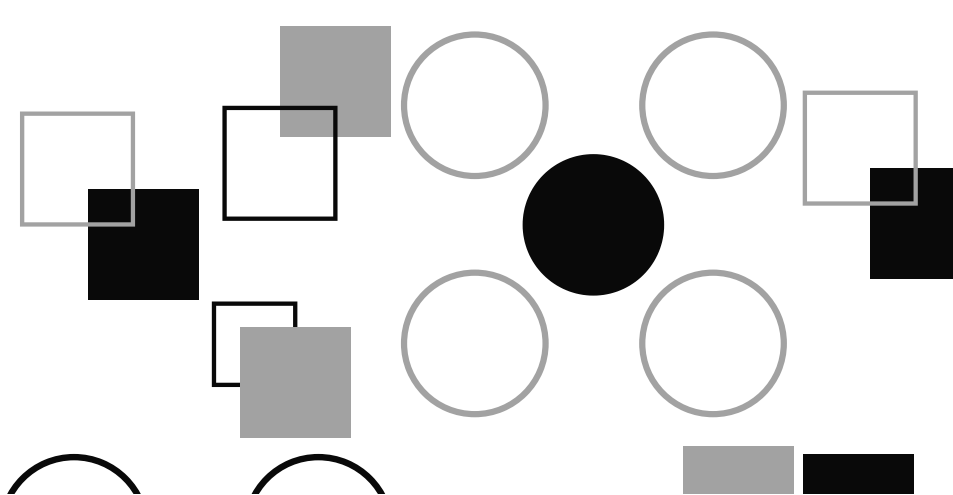
Install new cabinetry, ensuring proper alignment and securing them to the walls
